The Virgin Islands Track and Field Federation is staging the Virgin Islands Track and Field Championships on June 25 8am to 5pm at the Ivanna Eudora Kean High School Track in St. Thomas, V.I. The meet includes competition in running, jumping and throwing events for youths, junior, seniors and masters athletes.

This meet is held during the annual celebration of Olympic Month and will offer the rare opportunity for Virgin Islands National Track and Field Team Members who train and compete out of the territory to compete at home on the IAAF certified track which was installed in 2015. The competition is open to all including clubs, student/athletes, unattached individual athletes and invited international competitors.

Starting 2017 The V.I. National Track and Field Championship will honor CARL PLASKETT the first V.I. National Track and Field Team Member to win an international medal and each year thereafter a V.I.National Track and Field Team Member.
